Attention Marean Lake Advisory Board:

RE: Do Not Swim Advisory at Marean Lake Beach

Due to water contamination with *E. coli* bacteria, the safety of swimmers exposed to water at the public beach cannot be ensured at all times.

Therefore:

- Immediately notify all users of the public beach of the Do Not Swim Advisory by ensuring
 the signage that has been provided remains publicly posted until the advisory has been
 lifted.
- Posted signs should be at minimum located at or near all beach entrances or easily visible at or near the beach. Beach entryways, garbage cans, bathrooms, gates, or beach bulletin boards are examples of acceptable posting locations.

The advisory will remain in effect until a minimum of one set of five (5) samples are obtained and meet the guidelines of less than 235 E.coli/100 mL, indicating that E.coli levels in the water are acceptable.
